Photo Album Assembly: involves careful handcrafting, accurate measuring and cutting, neat gluing. Usually done once each year at the Ballard studio.

Prayer Flag Creation: involves stamping with paint on fabric, sewing strings of flags together, and packaging final product. Usually done at work parties at the Ballard studio; sewing may be done at home.

Tri-fold Book Assembly: involves accurate paper and mat board cutting skills, neat gluing, and folding of paper to assemble the book. Parts or all of the project may be done at your own home.

Tri-fold Book and Laminated Picture Pouches: involves cutting out and sewing up the suede pouches. May be done at your own home.

Annual Artist Sale: opportunities include the areas of Advertising, Coffee Bar, Raffle Basket, Cashiers, Greeters, Clean-up and more. The sale is in early December.

Fund Raising Parties: organizing fundraising parties to be held in private homes – guests make a set cash donation to attend the party, which is somewhat like paying to attend a nice cocktail party with your friends. All money goes directly to Soulumination.
